Prices include all equipment and materials needed to complete the activity. The actual minimum price will be determined by the combination of activity type(s) chosen, and the most recently anticipated item count as of 48 hours prior to your event date. So, if you estimate you will need 50 items, but then have only 40 participants, we will come prepared to do 50 and you will be obligated to pay for 50; what you do with the extra 10 items is up to you. A deposit of \$150 or more will be required to hold the date. A trip fee may apply for off-site events more than 50 miles from our studio. A rush fee may apply for large group events of less than 2.5 hours.

WHAT WE REQUIRE

Due to the nature of the art, we require a level space with enough room for the number of trays/tables needed to accommodate the activity, based on the size of the group and the type of activity. The work area must be protected from direct sun, wind, rain, etc. (we can provide pop up canopies). For off-site events, we require access to water (such as a garden spigot or janitor's sink) to fill 2 or more rinse buckets. We reserve the right to decline an event that does not meet these requirements, or which poses a perceived risk to our team, participants, or property, or for any other reason such as weather forecast, social unrest, health concerns, etc.

OUR TECHNIQUES

Water marbling, suminigashi, and shibori are all ancient traditional arts with roots in Japan, but are distinctly different in technique and style.

Marbling involves floating acrylic paint on an aqueous surface, then using various rakes, combs, and stylus to create intricate patterns, abstract designs, or nature-inspired motifs. A real crowd-pleaser, it has all the WOW factor to make your event unforgettable. It is what made Mayu Silk Art famous, and is by far our most popular technique. We will generally assume this is your preference unless you request something different.

Kanoko Shibori (Japanese tie dye). New to Mayu Silk Art, Shibori involves folding, twisting and tying the fabric before dipping it into an indigo dye bath. The finished designs may be somewhat patterned or random, depending on the way the artist works. The results are soft and beautiful, with a touch of "wabi sabi" (beautiful imperfection). This activity is best for adults, and requires some hand dexterity. Good for groups which have already tried the water marbling technique.

Suminigashi is the oldest known form of marbling. Originally done with ink on water, our more colorful, contemporary technique uses acrylic paint. Best for teens/adults. Up to 30 people at a time can be seated at their own small tray. Guests can be seated. Guests may opt to select from our sizable selection of rubber stamps to imprint their coasters with fun images or words before painting. Best as a make-and-take option for large events, or as a workshop for groups of 25 or more.

ITEM DESCRIPTION

Large silk scarves (14"x72") make a stunning piece of wearable art, or may be used as a table runner, sash, window covering, or wall décor. This is our most popular item for groups of all sizes. Suitable for marbling or shibori techniques.

Square silk scarves (22" x 22") are a fun accessory-sized art piece that can be worn as a bandanna or neckerchief, used as a furoshiki wrap, or framed. Cotton option available. Especially good for events where time, space or budget are limited, or whenever you want to keep the crowd moving. Suitable for marbling or shibori technique.

Tea towels (33" x 38") are made of 100% cotton and have a loop for hanging; they will add a pop of Japanese-styled flair to any kitchen or tea party. Tea towels are suitable only for shibori technique.

Paperboard coasters are 4" in diameter; **cotton charms** are 5" square (unhemmed). The small format (6" square) tray makes it easy to work independently and is a real crowd favorite! Only offered as part of the DIY Station add-on or casual make-and-take a-la-carte workshop for groups of 25 or more. Suitable for marbling or suminigashi techniques.

Bamboo/silk fans include a tassel and carry bag. This is a fun choice for the DIY station, and offers a low-cost Silk Bar option for groups of 50 or more. Suitable only for marbling technique.
